The seminar programme in cooperation with exhibitors & partners on static earthing of bulk trucks and tankers, cleaning techniques for dry production, robotics, digitalisation,... was appreciated. No less than 200 visitors attended one or more seminars during the show days.

There was a lot of experience at the show and live demos brought by the exhibitors were appreciated by the visitors. The Innovation Tour, a free guided tour of exhibitors' innovations, also attracted interest from visitors three times a day.

No fewer than three awards were handed out. The jury's Innovation Award went to the duo entry from Gericke and Indus Intergrated Bulk Logistics with the 'Big Bag Pallet Unloader'. The public's Innovation Award went to Engisol with their 'SmartPick' robotic system.

The exhibitor who brought the most visitors to the show at the end of the second day was also honoured with the Marketing Award. This award went to J-Tec Material Handling. Congratulations to all winners!
